- 2. What is something you recognized that needs to change in your life based on this week's readings?
- 3. Do you have any questions about anything you read this week?
- 4. In I Samuel 17 we have the familiar story of David & Goliath. Discuss with the group what you got out of this reading.
- 5. I Samuel 18:5 (NIV) says "Whatever Saul sent him to do, David did it so successfully." Success means having the intended result. Are we available like David to do successfully whatever we are asked or do we do just enough to get the job completed?
- 6. When the enemy attacks and we suffer loss, how do we respond? What three things do we see that David did in I Samuel 30: 6 9?
- 7. Read John 8: 31 32. What did Jesus say will set us free? If this sets you free, then what will keep you from being free? Is just knowing the truth enough according to verse 31? Explain.
- 8. Read John 10: 22 30. Who are the sheep? How does He speak to us? How do we know His voice?
- 9. According to John 11: 15, what was the reason that Jesus did not respond sooner to Mary and Martha's request for Jesus to come? Do you believe that God allows tough circumstances in our lives to increase our faith? Can you think of a situation in your life that you can share with your group?
- 10. Proverbs 15: 22. What does this verse say? What areas of life can this verse help us with if we apply it? Give examples.
